



Eligibility and Distribution of Bikes


Big Birmingham Bikes received, by Ward











Impact of Big Birmingham Bikes Scheme





























36 helped to gain employment through using their bike





Impact continued...

- 220 Bikes given away to children
- 66,000kg carbon offset
- 20 Community cycling clubs
- 5 Bike banks
- 40 ride leaders trained
- 17,841 New cyclists (this is combination of bikeability uniques, BBB giveaway recipients never cycled and learn to ride session uniques)
- Bringing in the unusual suspects
- Starting where they are at/ 'doing with' and not 'to'
- Moving from transactional to relational
- Developing a new pact with citizens
- Collaboration- bikes being given away by recipients from previous rounds/ community led cycling clubs




Managing risk
