LEARNINGS FROM THE DEVELOPMENT PHASE:

- Physical activity system is immature with 2 indicators 'developing well' and 3 indicators 'emerging'
- Leadership is creating new relationships and connections between systems
- Social Network Analysis identified 7 priority systems incorporating 97 different organisations
- The development phase identified 17 enablers and 18 barriers to shape the 3-year full award phase
