# **SAFEGUARDING IN 6** SAFEGUARDING FOR COMMITTEE MEMBERS

### **IT IS EVERYONE'S** RESPONSIBILITY

- Whilst club welfare officers lead on safeguarding & welfare concerns, ALL committee members share responsibility for ensuring the safety & wellbeing of participants.
- Actively promoting & supporting safeguarding should be part of every decision & discussion.

# **BUILDING A SAFEGUARDING CULTURE**

A positive safeguarding culture means

- Creating an environment where concerns are taken seriously
- Policies are relevant, up to date, and provide a practical working guide
- Appropriate behaviour is displayed at all times
- Club values of respect & inclusion are upheld
- Everyone feels safe to speak up, knowing they will be listened to & concern be acted upon

## **TRAINING & AWARENESS**

- Committee members should complete basic safeguarding awareness training and keep it up to date
- Understanding the signs of abuse, reporting procedures & the club's safeguarding policy enable informed & responsible decision-making.

#### **UNDERSTAND YOUR POLICIES & PROCEDURES**

- All committee members should be familiar with the club's safeguarding policy, codes of conduct & reporting procedures
- These all need to be reviewed regularly to ensure they are current & accessible to all.
- If you are affiliated to a National Governing Body (NGB) your policy needs to reflect their guidance

- Listening to the CWOs concerns & taking action when needed
- Make safeguarding a standing agenda item on all committee meetings

- making. This role complements the CWO by embedding a safeguarding lens at leadership level. It ensures
- Support for the CWO if issues escalate or require wider committee
