Maldon & District CVS



Maldon and District Community Voluntary Service (CVS) supports strong, thriving communities across the Maldon District. We help grow and strengthen the local voluntary and community sector for the benefit of residents and their neighbourhoods. Please see examples below supporting our voluntary sector:

Charity Consultancy & DBS - We offer tailored support for charities, including governance, funding, safeguarding, DBS checks, and training for voluntary and private organisations.

Community Support- We assist residents in accessing essential supplies and services, especially those facing food or fuel poverty. We offer emergency help for individuals and families in crisis and coordinate the Community Support Network, which meets quarterly to share insights and connect services.

Suicide Prevention - We lead a multi-agency network to reduce suicide risk and support those affected. This includes identifying vulnerable individuals and areas, and directing resources to provide timely help.


The Community Fund
