Additional Summer Projects Funded for Children with SEND

Through funding from the Department for Education's Holiday Activity and Food programme, Essex ActivAte were able to provide an additional **5,841** SEND club places for children from low-income families or those receiving income-related Free School Meals, ensuring inclusive access to enriching activities throughout the summer.

Essex ActivAte also partnered with the Essex Library Team to deliver an additional nine sessions across libraries across Essex, featuring the Travelling Librarian and the enchanting experience titled "Honey, I Shrank the Librarian!" These sensory storytelling adventures invited children to immerse themselves in magical tales, brought to life through interactive story cases filled with props, songs, and imaginative play, creating a joyful and inclusive environment that sparked curiosity and a love for reading.
